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THE BEST TOOLS FOR REMOTE TEAMS

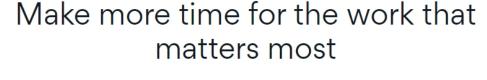

Project Management Tools

Asana is the work management platform teams use to stay focused on the goals, projects, and daily tasks that grow business.



Asana is not as advanced as some other project management tools; it's a simple powerful solution, which requires minimal training.

Asana offers a free basic package for individuals or teams just getting started, its Premium package cost \$11.99 per user per month and the Business package cost \$23.99 per user per month. If paying annually discounts apply.

Project Management Tools

One of the most popular project management tools, Basecamp, packs a lot of functionality without needing much training. With Basecamp you have real-time chat, do-do lists, schedules, messages, file storage, documents, automatic checks-ins and many more futures.

Basecamp offers 30 days for free and after that the cost is \$99 per month for the team, no matter how many people work in the team.

Communication Tools

Is really important to have the right communication tool in place for Remote Team members. These tools will help the Remote Team members collaborate across departments and keep a clear and efficient communication with every member of the organization.



Slack is where work happens

Slack is a collaboration hub, where the right people and the right information come together, helping everyone get work done. Slack would help you get your company and remote team organized with is powerful messaging app. In Slack, conversations happen in channels — organized by topic, project, team, or whatever makes sense for your company. With channels, the right people don't get left out and information doesn't get lost. Slack also has video and voice calls as well as screen sharing.

Slack has a free version for small teams and its standard version cost \$8 per user per month while is Plus version cost \$15 per user per month. If billed annually there's a discount.

Communication Tools

Flawless video. Clear audio. Instant sharing. Zoom is one of the best videoconference software, you can have video meetings with up to 1,000 participants, video webinars, conference rooms, business IM and screen sharing.

Zoom has a basic free plan where you can host 1 to 1 meeting with up to 100 participants, its Pro plan goes to \$14.99 per host per month and its business plan goes to \$19,99 per host per month.

Time Tracking Tools

A time tracking software allows its employees to record time spent on task and projects, as well as to monitor their team members.



Spend less time tracking and more time growing

Employee time tracking software with screenshots, reporting and automated payments.

Hubstaff makes it possible to know, in real time, how much each team member is working and on what. It comes with nice extra futures such as time tracking, productivity monitoring, reporting, GPS tracking, team scheduling, online timesheets. You can see the work in progress with optional screenshots, track app and URL activity as well as capture activity levels based on keyboard and mouse usage. It can be integrated with Basecamp, Asana and more apps.

Hubstaff is free for 1 user, from there the basic plan is \$5 per month per user and the Premium for \$10 per month per user. If paid annually you get a discount.
